

Communication, Language and Literacy:

- Practice our name writing
- Make words on the magnetic boards (linked to read write inc)
- Listen to different versions of the story and retell it. Make a story map as a class.
- Write a list of the characters from the story
- Play a listening game using the farm animals
- Feed Oscar the box monster different pictures (practising our blending)
- Share our reading book with a grown up
- Take part in daily Read Write inc sessions

Personal & Social & Emotional Development:

- Talk about the importance of helping and not being selfish like the characters in the story
- Decide if you would help the little red hen and why?
