

Communication, Language and Literacy:

- Talk about what happens to our letter after it is written.

- Practicing one more, one less
- Practicing prepositional language
- Exploring and using numicon within the nursery environment

- Make Christmas cards.
- Make Christmas play costumes.
- Making our own creations in the creative corner.
- Exploring and making musical instruments, link to superhero sounds - crash, bang, kapow. Christmas songs.
- Introduce moving body through music & movement.
