- Practice with mark making
- Practising pencil control

- Introducing 2D shapes, making pictures and patterns
- Sorting into sizes, small, big, bigger
- Sorting and matching, shapes, colours and numbers
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### **Creative Development:**

- Making a dragon using junk modelling
- Taking part in a dragon dance for the new year
- Use imagination to explore role play
- Make a 2D shape dragon
- Trying Chinese writing and making a red envelope
- Make pig biscuits
- Make pig & wolf masks

What happens in the story? Who are the characters? Can you tell me who is celebrating their new year? How do they celebrate?
