**Makaton signs** - Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Days of the week, Months of the Year, Please, Thank you, Yes, No, Ok, Happy, Sad, Sorry, More, Letters of their names, water, milk, fruit, weather.

**RWI signs** – My Turn, Your Turn (MTYT) Team Stop, Turn To Your Partner (TTYP)

### Reminder or Any other news:

Can you help your child to identify shapes and numbers in the environment, when you are at home, or out and about. Play I Spy with my little eye something that is a circle (use verbal clues and language to describe the shape, e.g. 'It is round, it is black' describing the tyre on a car. You can also play 'I spy' when looking for numerals or counting. Using car number plates, house numbers, counting objects on walks.
