Physical Development:

- To develop scissor control & use them safely

Understanding of the World:

Key Questions

Discuss the story of Goldilocks and the Three bears. Was Goldilocks good or bad for going into the bears house? Did Goldilocks listen to her Mummy? Discuss rules.

Mathematics:

- Practicing counting 1-10
- Identifying shapes in the environment
- Practicing number recognition & number formation
- Using the interactive board – counting, matching, number and shape recognition.

Creative Development:

- Use imagination to explore role play
- Create bear mask using a variety of materials and textures.
- Exploring colours through paint, drawing, mark making.
- Experiment with playdough, explore using different textures and resources.
- To experiment with different textures – oats.

Key Vocabulary – family/families, parents, grandparents, sister, brother, pets, types of houses. opposites – on/off, up/down, in/out, boy/girl, hot/cold, wet/dry, first/last, prepositional language – in, on, under, in front of, beside, next to.

Makaton signs - Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Days of the week, Months of the Year, Please, Thank you, Yes, No, Ok, Happy, Sad, Sorry, More, Letters of their names, water, milk, fruit, weather.

RWI signs – My Turn, Your Turn (MTYT) Team Stop, Turn To Your Partner (TTYP)
