Physical Development:

- Learning to be independent, take off and put on own shoes and coats.

Key Questions

Mathematics:

- Use numicon to count and match 1-5 / 1-10
- Practicing number recognition – using number line and numicon 1-5
- To identify how many objects are in a set.
- Using the interactive board – counting, matching, number and shape recognition.
- To sing counting and shape songs

Creative Development:

- Use imagination to explore roleplay and use props to retell stories.
- Make a dinosaur using a variety of resources.
- To take part in a movement session – express feelings using movement/ listening to music.
- To explore dinosaurs and ice cubes.

Key Vocabulary – Palaeontologist, herbivore, carnivore, Tyrannosaurus rex, ice, frozen, melting, cold, wet, names of dinosaurs, descriptive words - spiky, sharp, bumpy, smooth, gooey, slimy, sparkly, prepositional language – in front, behind, on, in, under, over, next to, beside. Learning powers
Makaton signs - Days of the week, Months of the Year, Ok, Happy, Sad, Sorry, More, First letter of their names, water, milk, fruit, dinosaur,
RWI signs – My Turn, Your Turn (MTYT) Team Stop, Turn To Your Partner (TTYP)
