Maths

In maths this week we will be looking how we can solve subtraction calculations by counting backwards on the number line. We will also be learning about the 8 calculations we can do to make a fact family. (White Rose, Autumn 2, Weeks 5-8).

English and Phonics

This week in English we will be reading 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London' and starting to learn about The Great Fire of London. We will be writing a letter to Vlad asking him a question. We will be learning new vocabulary based on the story.
