<b>Y</b> 6	Sikhism: Deeper study of the Gurus, the Golden Temple, and the concepts of equality and service.	Hinduism: Exploring key deities (Brahma, Vishnu, Shiva), sacred texts, and Hindu festivals (e.g., Diwali).	Comparative Study: Synthesising learning from KS2 to make informed comparisons and articulate personal understanding.
